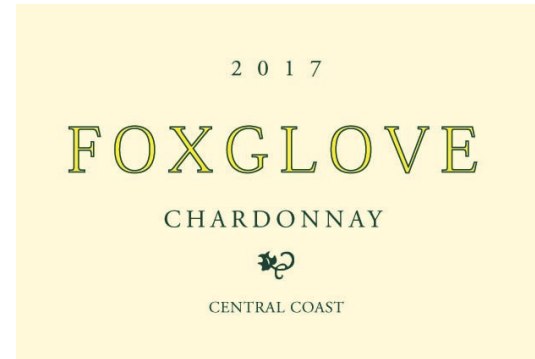


# FOXGLOVE

## 2017 Chardonnay Central Coast

100% Chardonnay, 96% Santa Barbara County, 4% Paso Robles  
Clone 4 and Dijon Clones, vines between 13 and 33 years old, 630 -1000 ft elevation  
Vertical Shoot Positioned Canopy, planted on rolling hills of sandy loam and loam soils  
Stainless steel 62° , 3 week fermentation., lees stirred, no malolactic fermentation  
13.8%Alcohol 0.64 TA 3.42 pH .03 R.S.

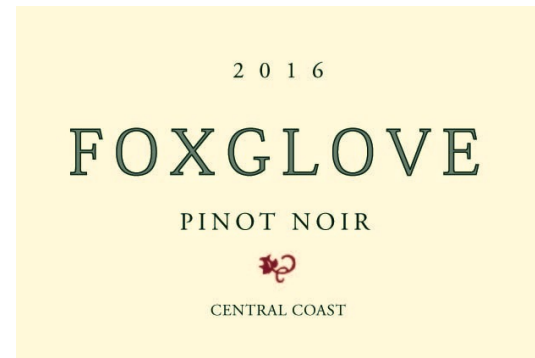

## 2016 Pinot Noir Central Coast

100% Pinot Noir, Pommard and 777 clones, Santa Barbara County  
Sandy loam soils, sloped, 600 ft elevation, 14 miles from Pacific Ocean  
100% de-stemmed, pressed at dryness, malolactic completed after pressing  
13.8% Alcohol 0.56 TA 3.90 pH .07 R.S.

“The 2016 Pinot Noir is another superb value from brothers Jim and Bob Varner. Succulent red/purplish berry fruit, spice, hard candy and floral notes jump from the glass a exuberant, racy Pinot Noir loaded with character. Ripe, racy flavors and mid-weight structure make for a compelling and delicious bottle of wine. Aging in steel keeps the fruit bright “

## 2016 Zinfandel Paso Robles

86% Zinfandel, 14% Petite Sirah, 100% Paso Robles, 25 year average age of vines  
Northern Area of Paso Robles, planted on rolling hills, loam soils, 900-1,000 ft elevation  
100% de-stemmed, pressed at dryness, malolactic completed after pressing  
14.3% Alcohol 0.58 TA 3.74 pH .01 R.S.

“The 2016 Zinfandel is a fresh, fruity wine to drink now and over the next few years. Juicy black cherry, leather, spice, menthol and cedar add character to this exuberant , racy Zinfandel. This is an especially floral, mid-weight style”

## 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon Paso Robles

100% Cabernet Sauvignon, 100% Paso Robles, 20 year average age of vines  
Northern Area of Paso Robles, planted on rolling hills, loam soils, 900-1,000 ft elevation  
100% de-stemmed, pressed at dryness, malolactic completed after pressing  
14.2% Alcohol 0.58 TA 3.77 pH .05 R.S.

“ The 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon Paso Robles shows just how appealing the vintage is. Aging in steel and bottling early brings out the aromatic, juicy side of Cabernet. The 2018 is not exactly complex, but it is absolutely delicious. It will make a terrific house pour over the next few years.”
